Prior Learning

The level 2 Princes Trust Diploma is part of the Level 2 programme which includes the opportunity to improve on key stage 4 exam performance in core GCSEs of Mathematics and English and also achieve an IT qualification. During the course students will have the opportunity to consolidate their numeracy, literacy and IT skills.

Curriculum Intent – What are the curriculum aims?

The Prince's Trust qualification in Personal Development and Employability Skills (Level 2 Diploma) recognises a breadth of personal skills, qualities and attitudes required by employers across a range of sectors. They have been developed with the aim of progressing learners into further education and/or employment. They give learners the opportunity to:

- Develop their own personal growth and engagement in, and through, learning
- Engage in learning that is relevant to them and support their development of personal skills and attributes that are essential for working life and employment
- Prepare themselves for progression into further education programmes, apprenticeships or other work based learning
- Develop their English and mathematics skills

Curriculum Impact – How will my child be assessed and receive feedback?

The Prince's Trust Diploma is 100% coursework-assessed with no formal exam. Students build a portfolio of evidence throughout which is submitted to the awarding body at the end of the course.

Evidence is collated through a range of different resources such as

- completion of a workbook
- submission of assignments
- observation of presentations
- observation of practical activities.

Student progress is tracked throughout the course and they are provided with regular verbal feedback on their progress towards successfully achieving each element of the course during lessons and written feedback at the end of each tracked unit.
