Re: Plume Enrichment Passport

Having launched Plume Enrichment Passport to students last week, I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your continued support with this and provide a brief update. It has been really lovely to speak to students about the tasks and also to find out about all of the extra-curricular activities they do that are being used to collect bonus stamps. Students have all now received their passport and there is a shiny postbox ready for completed cards to be posted into at the office.

As a reminder, tasks can be accessed as detailed below:

- **Mathematics** - students need to log onto MathsWatch and complete the relevant assigned task. Students have been set a task that is appropriate to the class they are in, and which enables them to consolidate their learning from this academic year. When they have completed the maths task, they should take their passport to their mathematics teacher to be signed and dated.
- **English** - students should read a book of their choice. They may wish to choose from the recommended list, but they may choose any book. When they have finished the book, they should complete the linked Student Book Review Form to leave a book review. Once this is completed, they should take their passport to their English teacher to be signed.
- **Science** - students should log into Seneca and use the link shared to access the task in Seneca. Again, once completed they should ask their science teacher to sign their passport.
