THE PRINCE'S TRUST AT KEY STAGE 4.

The Prince's Trust Achieve Programme helps 11 to 19 year-olds develop the skills and confidence they need to reach their goals, through relevant, engaging and informal learning. Our Key Stage 4 Prince's Trust Qualification is offered to those students who the academy feel will help develop to get the most out of the Key Stage 4 flexible learning pathway. The programme has been designed as a one-year programme which is run throughout year 10 through to 11 with the main learning aim being at certificate level. However we recognise that all student needs and educational path can change as students become older and clearer on their career pathway. To ensure that this can be catered for the team are able to tailor the qualification to the individual. Units are specially selected to cater for the needs of the cohort and to help them develop the skills needed to be successful at Key Stage 4 and beyond.

KEY STAGE 5 PATHWAY.

As well as a Key Stage 4 pathway the Flexible Learning Faculty offers a post 16 pathway. This is designed around a level 2 programme, with its primary function to help students achieve their next steps.

The programme is made up of a number of qualifications which prepare the students for the next level of academic learning at level 3, successful application onto apprenticeship schemes or into full time employment. The programme is built around a timetable of 20 guided learning hours (GLH) per week

The suite of qualifications includes;

- The Prince's Trust Qualification in Personal Development and Employability (PDE) at level 2
- Cambridge National Digital Business Qualification at level 2
- Opportunity to resist Maths and/or English at Level 2 (GCSE)

PRINCE'S TRUST AT KEY STAGE 5.

The Prince's Trust Achieve Programme helps 11 to 19 year-olds develop the skills and confidence they need to reach their goals, through relevant, engaging and informal learning.

Education should prepare young people for the future they want, however, many experience challenges with attendance, attainment and motivation, putting them at risk of underachieving or exclusion. The Achieve Programme is designed to help young people re-engage with education and support them to achieve their full potential.

The Prince's Trust Achieve Programme is uniquely designed to help young people aged 11 to 19 to re-engage with education, using a flexible, modular structure to improve young people's attendance, behaviour and attainment.



WHAT SKILLS AND QUALIFICATIONS WILL STUDENTS GAIN?

The Achieve Programme curriculum promotes a flexible approach, using relevant, experiential learning to support young people to achieve a range of personal and employability skills and gain qualifications.

The Academy's Key Stage 5 programme has been designed around the students' needs by selecting the most appropriate units from the suite to ensure students are best prepared for their next steps after year 12.

HOW IT WORKS

The Faculty choose a combination of individual units from across the six modules, selecting the most relevant content for needs of the cohort. The qualification is delivered across 10 hours of the student's timetable, with one of these hours being used as a learning group to ensure that students follow a similar PSD programme as other college students.

The qualification has been designed not only to include relevant units which students can engage in, but also allow students to achieve at the highest level with the main learning aim being the full diploma at level 2. However, the academy also recognises that student needs and educational path can change as students become older and clearer on their career pathway. To ensure that this can be catered for the team have designed the qualification to allow students to “step off” at set points in the year. Students will receive accreditation in the qualification but at a slightly lower level than the full diploma. All units have literacy and numeracy opportunities embedded throughout to help support other curriculum areas being studied on the course.

CAMBRIDGE NATIONAL IN DIGITAL BUSSINESS.

In the current digital age, the academy understands the importance of ensuring level 2 students continue to develop their understanding how business function and how digital technology is used within business to run effectively and efficiently. To ensure students are suitably qualified students undertake a level 2 digital qualification as part of the course.

The course is 100% coursework which suits the learning style of students on the course and covers 2 units;

- **UNIT 8:** USING EMERGING TECHNOLOGIES

- **UNIT 13:** CREATING WEBSITES

All work is marked and moderated internally. An external moderator ensures the grades awarded meet national standards. The course takes 3 hours of the students 18-hour timetable.

- Shared decision making


DwD equips teachers with classroom skills and techniques that enable them to spend less time on behavioural issues and more time on positive interactions with students.
