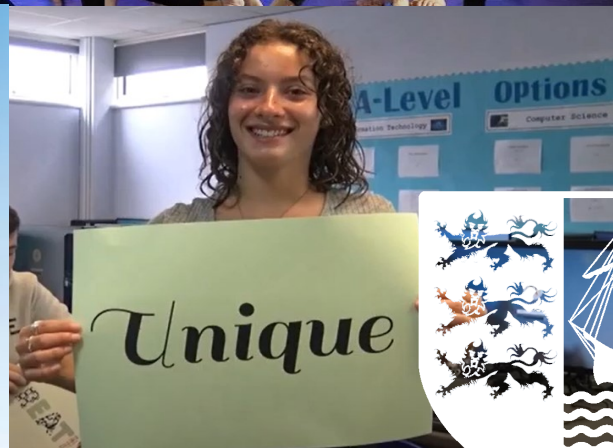
Why get involved?

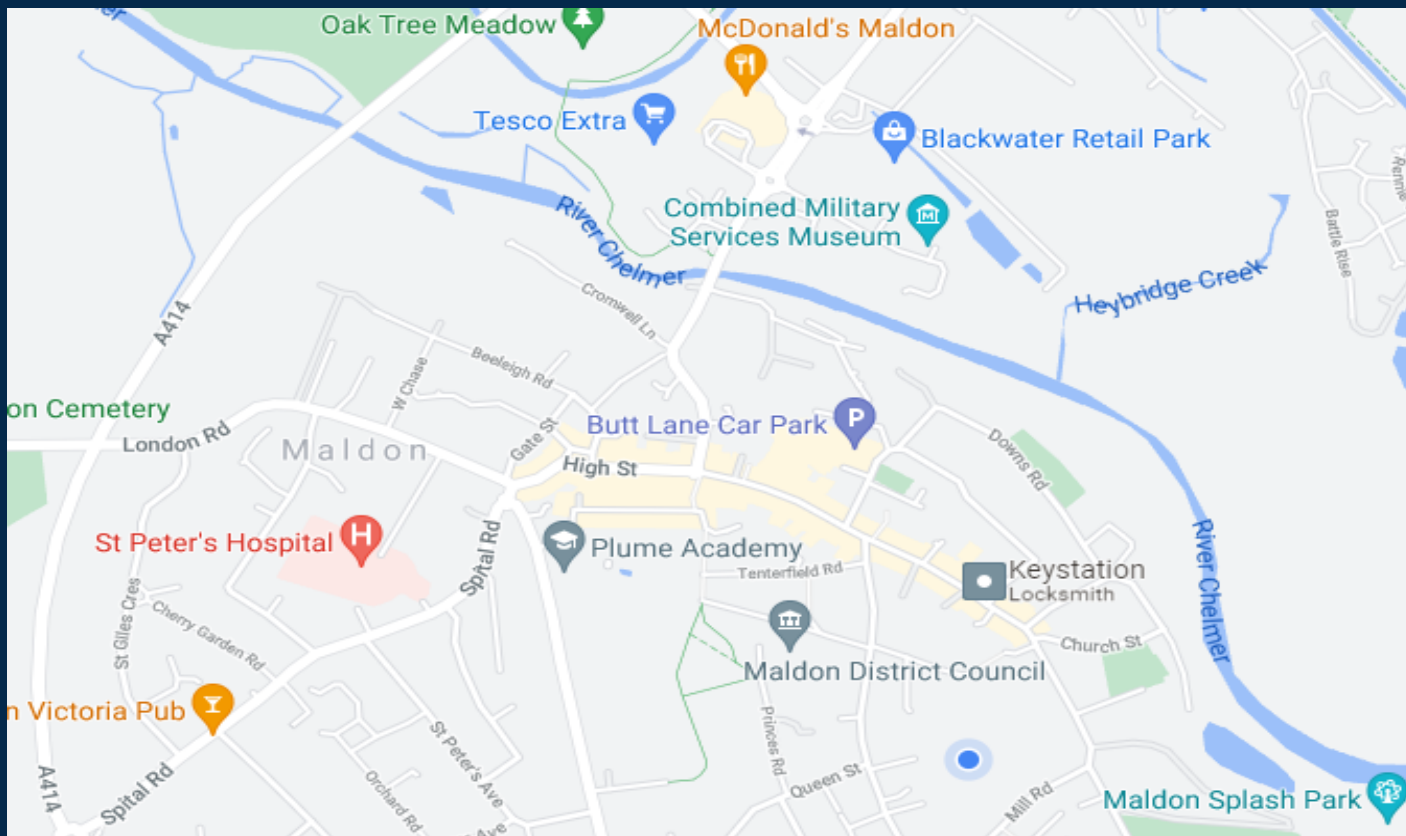
Research shows that student performance and motivation can improve as they gain a deeper understanding of the relevance of education and qualifications in the workplace and community.
